**10th Annual Stockton Alumni Legacy Fund 5K Moves to Atlantic City in Conjunction with the Atlantic City Marathon Race Weekend**

September 6, 2017 / Margate, NJ - The Atlantic City Marathon Race Series is excited to announce a new partnership with Stockton University to bring the 10th Annual Stockton Alumni Legacy Fund 5K to Atlantic City in conjunction with the Atlantic City Marathon. Our annual 5K will now raise money for scholarships in honor of the late G. Larry James, Stockton University's former director of Athletics and Recreation and an Olympic gold medalist.

The Atlantic City Marathon race weekend, sponsored by AmeriHealth New Jersey, AtlantiCare, 95.1 WAYV, the Borgata, the Rothman Institute, Double Nickle Brewing Company, Dick's Sporting Goods, Harry's Oyster Bar and Bally's Atlantic City offers a race distance for every runner and walker including the 5K, 10K, half marathon and marathon all starting on the historic Atlantic City Boardwalk in front of Bally's.

Each 5K participant will be running to benefit the G. Larry James Legacy Endowed Scholarship Fund to support students attending Stockton University.

The G. Larry James Endowment Fund, which receives the net proceeds from the 5K, was created in memory of James, called "The Mighty Burner." He won a gold medal as a member of the 1968 United States Olympic 4 x 400-meter relay team, which held the longest-standing world record in the sport of Track and Field. He won a silver medal for the 400-meter event at the same Olympic Games in Mexico City.

James was inducted into the National Track & Field Hall of Fame in 2003 and into Stockton's Athletics Hall of Fame in 2010.
